

Structure and marking of the admissions for the bachelor's programme in Dance Theory

The admission procedure will take place over 2 rounds.

Round 1 – presence – written test

- 1) written test on general cultural maturity, history and theory of dance and ballet, history and theory of music;
- 2) written analysis of a sample of choreography (focusing on dance style/technique, components and form, artistic context, possibly identifying the specific work).

At least 20 out of a possible 25 points are required to proceed to the next round. If candidates do not receive the minimum mark, the admission procedure will be terminated. If a candidate proceeds to Round 2, the marks from Round 1 are not counted in Round 2.

Round 2 – presence – oral examination

The oral talent examination consists of a specialist interview in which candidates must demonstrate their knowledge and abilities in the following areas:

- 1) history of dance (combined with an assessment of candidates' language skills in the selected foreign language);
- 2) knowledge of contemporary dance;
- 3) motivation to study and ideas for specialisation.

The admission commission will award candidates a summary mark ranging from 1 to 25 points. This mark is an assessment of candidates' capacity for logical and systematic thought, expressive and stylistic skills, knowledge of the dance scene in the Czech Republic and abroad, basic knowledge of the history of dance and ballet, knowledge of the foundations of music theory, history of music and theatre, general cultural knowledge, dance experience and basic knowledge of dance techniques (classical, modern and contemporary, folk).

After Round 2 the admission commission will draw up a ranking based on the average of candidates' marks in Round 2 and will recommend for admission those candidates who finished in a position corresponding to the target number for the Dance Theory study discipline, provided that their Round 2 mark is at least 20 points.

If there are not enough candidates with high enough marks, the target number will be left unfilled.
